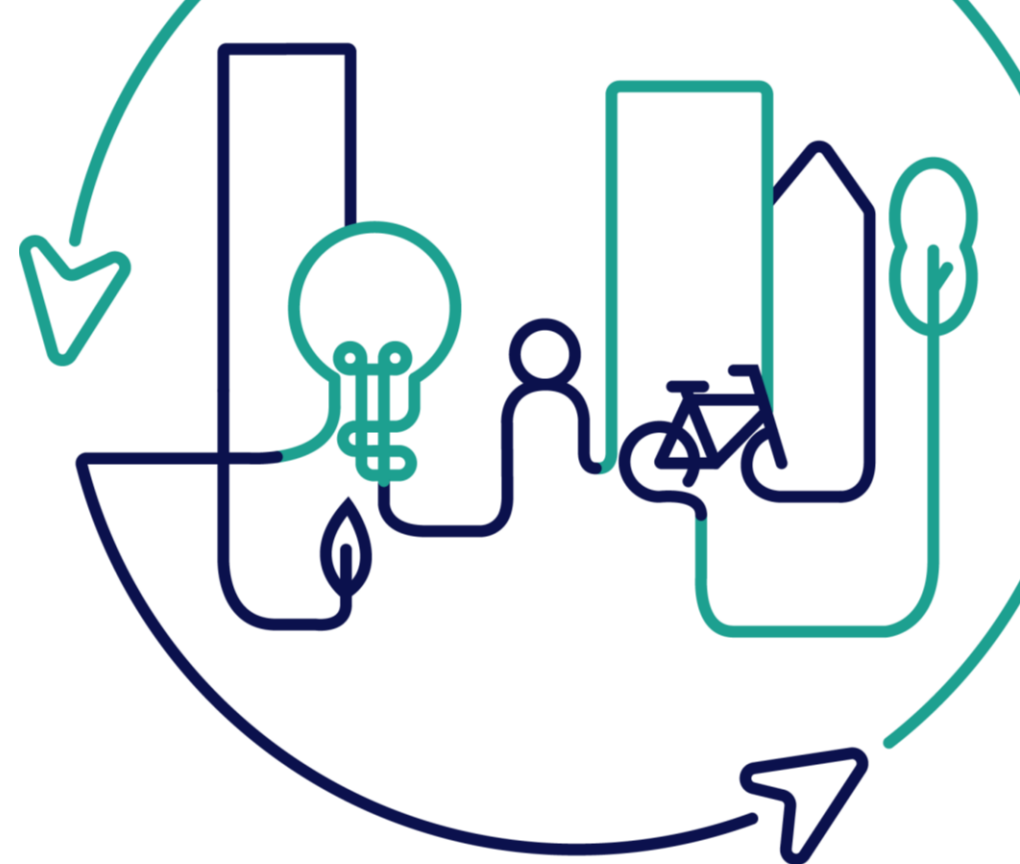

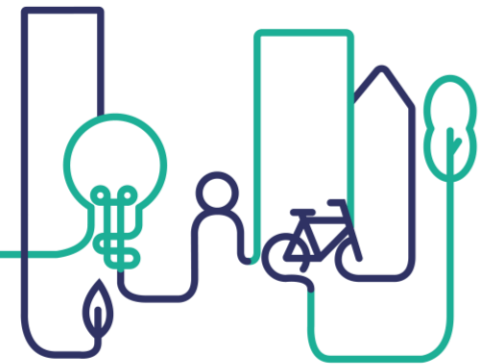

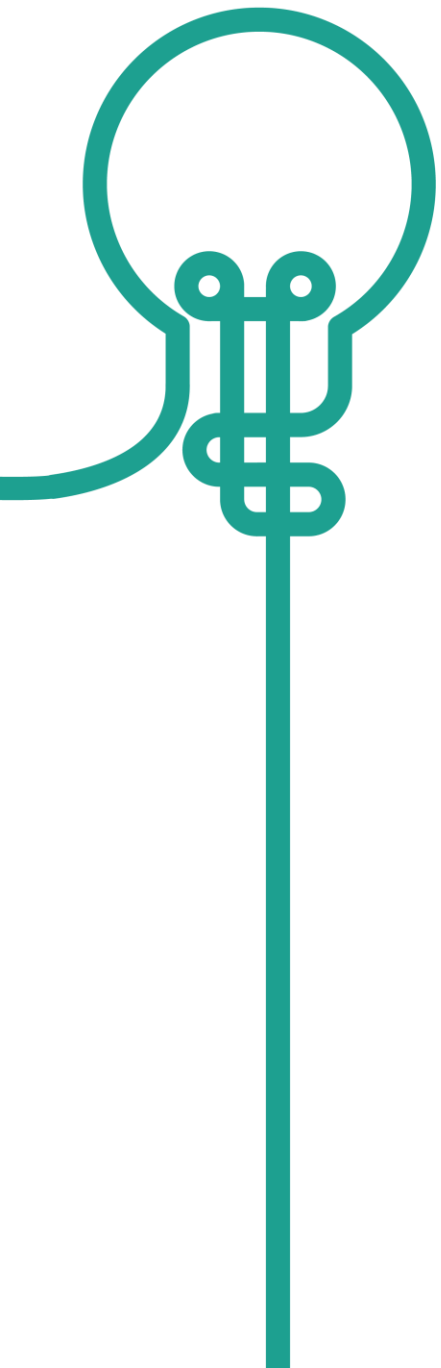

MAYOR'S OFFICE



1

Municipality of Budapest: elected body, represented by the General Assembly, led by the Mayor

2

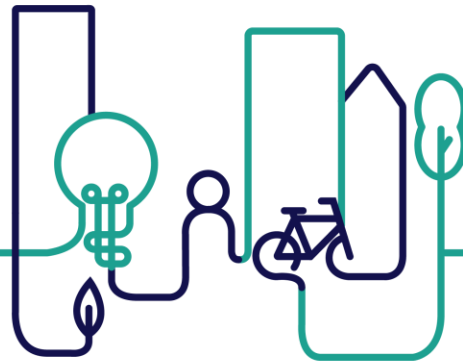
Mayor's Office: executive body of the Municipality, led by the Chief Clerk

Structure of Mayor's Office: civil servants, 900 employees, 14 main departments, 5 horizontal offices, 5 political offices

MAYOR'S OFFICE: EU FUNDED PROJECT EXPERIENCES

- **82 national Operative Programs funded projects** 805 million EUR grant (2007-2020)
- Currently **14 direct-EU funded projects** more than 10 million EUR grant (including AHA Budapest)
- Continuous involvement of **horizontal** (finance, HR, legal) and **thematic departments** (City Operations, Climate and Environment, Urban Planning)
- Regular involvement of **Municipality owned companies** (transport, utilities, green area management, public catering)
