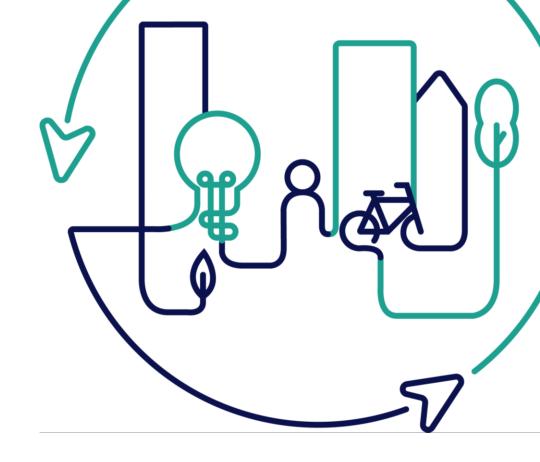





MUNICIPALITY OF BUDAPEST MAYOR'S OFFICE



- Municipality of Budapest: elected body, represented by the General Assembly, led by the Mayor
- Mayor's Office: executive body of the Municipality, led by the Chief Clerk
- Structure of Mayor's Office: civil servants, 900 employees, 14 main departments, 5 horizontal offices, 5 political offices

MAYOR'S OFFICE: EU FUNDED PROJECT EXPERIENCES

- > **82 national Operative Programs funded projects** 805 million EUR grant (2007-2020)
- Currently 14 direct-EU funded projects more than 10 million EUR grant (including AHA Budapest)
- Continuous involvement of horizontal (finance, HR, legal) and thematic departments (City Operations, Climate and Environment, Urban Planning)
- Regular involvement of **Municipality owned companies** (transport, utilities, green area management, public catering)






TARGETS TO BE ACHIEVED 1/3

Expanding social housing in Budapest

- Creating and piloting safe, flexible and innovative housing schemes
- Creating and testing a model for converting **unused public buildings** into quality affordable housing
- Expanding the capacity of Budapest Housing Agency with new groups of property owners and new, innovative schemes






TARGETS TO BE ACHIEVED 2/3

Improving energy efficiency in housing

- Energy-efficient renovation of cityowned properties and social rented housing
- One-stop shop consultancy on energy efficiency interventions in residential buildings
- Creation of a **Revolving Solidarity Fund** for the needy in energy poverty






TARGETS TO BE ACHIEVED 3/3

Destigmatising the social rental housing system

- Establish and operate an **Early Warning System** to support the avoidance of housing loss
- Involving tenants in participation processes and housing maintenance of Housing Agency
- Establishing **cooperation models** with market actors to expand flexible social housing schemes
